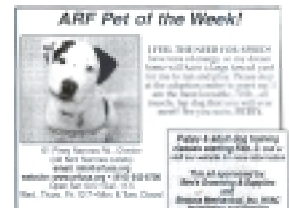

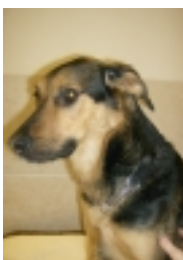

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

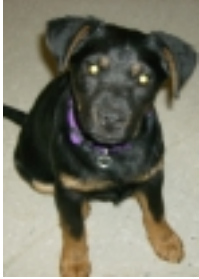

With our animal increase we will need help with the **transportation of our animals** to their vet appointments.

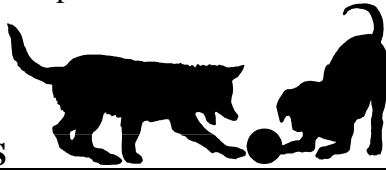
Our monthly Update will be mailed at the end of each month. If you would like to help **with printing, stuffing envelopes and organizing our bulk mailing** please contact the office

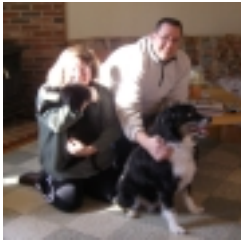
